### DANCE INSTRUCTORS FOR ADVANCED LEVELS (WEEKLY STAFF & SUBSTITUTE POOL)

The Schauer School of the Arts has immediate openings for professional ballet and contemporary instructors on our weekly team as well as within our substitute pool. The ideal candidate would have strengths in teaching Contemporary Dance, Advanced Ballet, and/or Pointe. Job requirements:

- Teaching advanced level Ballet and Pointe, and/or all levels of Contemporary
- Availability of one to two nights per week during the school year (additional summer opportunities are available)
- A commitment to maintain a consistent schedule for the long term
- Lesson planning that reflects an intentional, cohesive purpose and curriculum
- Mindfulness to movement techniques and practices that assure the safety of our dancers
- Choreographic collaborations with Schauer colleagues for our annual May ballet showcase

#### Additional Qualifications:

- Education : High school diploma, GED, or equivalent
- Minimum of 2 years of teaching experience in the style related to applicant's interest
- Knowledge of the terminology, basic pedagogy, and history related to the style of applicant's interest
- Dance training from an accredited college program and/or professionally recognized company or studio
- Strong written and verbal skills which ensure healthy communications between students, staff, and families
- Must be willing to teach a mock class & agree to a background check as part of the hiring process

#### General Schedule

The bulk of our Schauer School of the Arts classes are scheduled on weeknights and Saturday mornings.

In addition, there are occasional opportunities to teach mornings and early afternoons for visiting schools, private lessons, and homeschool families.

#### Compensation

Instructors are paid hourly for weekly teaching hours, and receive additional stipends for participation in workshops, camps, and the May showcase. Hourly compensation for teaching hours ranges from \$20-\$25 per hour based on training and experience.

The Schauer School of the Arts offers classes in dance, music, theater, and visual art for all ages and abilities. Our staff is made up of experienced teaching artists and educators who understand the value of professional creative arts training for all regardless of one's path in life. We strive to provide serious training in a nurturing environment. Collaborations between various School of the Arts colleagues and departments, as well as the pursuit of performance opportunities for our students throughout the southeast Wisconsin community are supported and strongly encouraged.
