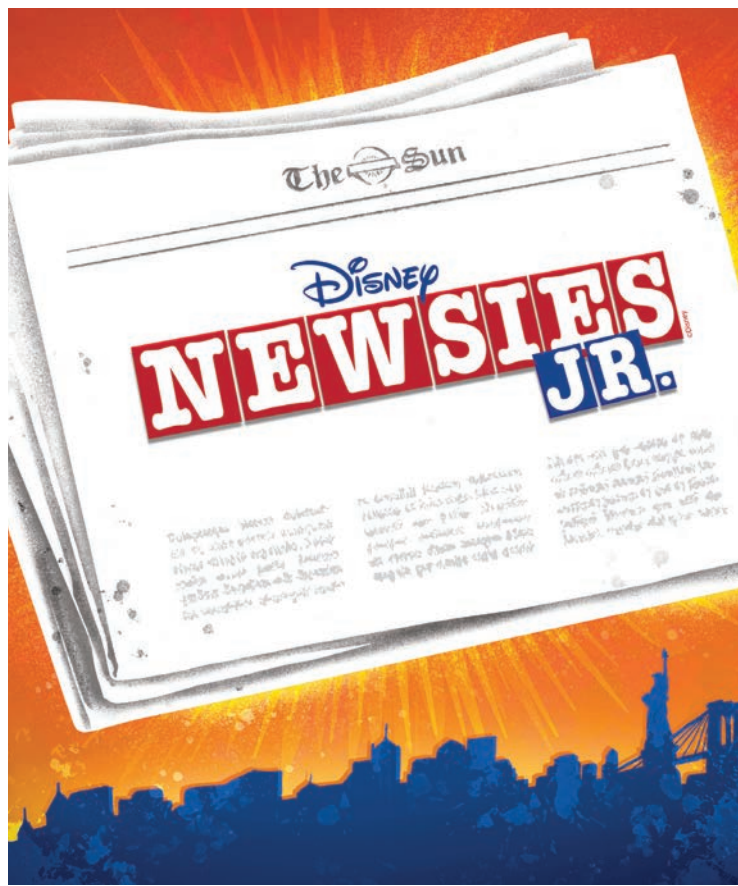

If you have multiple students auditioning, each student needs to be pre-registered for an individual timeslot. These can be in the same block of time.

A link to complete the Audition Form, Conflict Calendar and Student Waiver will be sent with a confirmation email after registration is completed. After these forms are submitted, a link to audition materials will be available. For students in grades 6-12, music selections and script sections will also be included. Music and script sections do not need to be memorized. These selections are given to help your students feel prepared for their audition. It helps your student to be familiar with the content that will be used during auditions.
