MISSOULA CHILDREN'S THEATRE: TREASURE ISLAND

Entering Grades 1-12



The Missoula Children's Theatre takes pride in presenting *Treasure Island*, an original adaptation of Robert Louis Stevenson's epic novel. Young Jim Hawkins, a mischievous lad, lives with his mother and six sisters in a seaside village on the coast of Maine. The year is 1782, and the American War for Revolution is in its last days. Longing for adventure, Jim comes under the hypnotic spell of the legendary pirate, Long John Silver. While waiting tables in the family Inn, Jim finds a treasure map and, with the villainous Silver as his seeming mentor, sails uncharted seas with only the ragged map and a flock of Gulls as guides. Always up for an adventure, Jim's Ruffian friends say farewell to their Mariner parents and serve as cabin boys for Silver and his band of hilarious (although unsavory) Pirate types. Once on the

island, nights are sleepless as true colors are revealed in our hero's quest for the proverbial happy ending. Then—at last—the treasure is found and hand in hand we're homeward bound.

Each year, Missoula Children's Theatre drives a little red truck from Montana to the Schauer Center. Two professional MCT tour actors/directors hold public auditions, casting local school-age children in an hour-long original musical. The cast rehearses for a week and then performs a fully staged and costumed show.

AUDITION

Monday, August 18, 10:00 am-12:00 pm. Pre-registration for the audition is recommended. **The audition begins promptly at 10:00 am, and no late arrivals are allowed.** The group-style audition will last 90-120 minutes and will be facilitated by the Missoula staff members. Students must participate for the full duration. Parents/caregivers are welcome to observe the audition. Casting will be announced immediately following the audition. Auditionees should bring a bag lunch to begin rehearsing that afternoon if they are cast in the show.

REHEARSALS

Following the audition and casting on Monday, an exact rehearsal schedule for each participant will be distributed. The possible rehearsal time frames that your child may be required to attend are Monday, 12:15-2:15 pm, Tuesday-Friday, 10:00 am-12:00 pm, and 12:15-2:15 pm. **Students cast in the show must be available for all rehearsals, with no exceptions.**

REGISTRATION/TUITION

Students cast in the performance must register for the production no later than Wednesday, August 20.

Missoula Children's Theater tuition is \$100/cast members & \$70/crew members (including two complimentary tickets for the show.)

Every student who auditions is invited to attend our **FREE** Missoula workshop series! Workshops are scheduled for 2:45-3:45 pm on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday during Missoula's residency week.
