Class Size: All SSA classes carry a minimum/ maximum class size that determines if the class will be offered. Classes not meeting the minimum may be canceled. Maximum levels are determined by classroom space or instructor/student ratios.

Payment Plans may be arranged for any class over \$100. A minimum of 25% of the tuition fee must be paid prior to the start of the first class/ rehearsal. Payment plans must be paid with a credit or debit card, that is kept on file for an automatic withdrawal.

Financial Aid: Need-based assistance is offered on a first come, first serve basis. Applications available upon request.

Refunds: A 50% refund of the tuition in the form of a gift certificate will be in effect through the second class/rehearsal. After the second class, NO REFUNDS
