

REHEARSAL INFORMATION

The first rehearsal and parent meeting will be Thursday, October $24^{\rm th}$ from 4:30-6:30 pm, where cast/crew will receive detailed schedule information and read through the script. Specific rehearsal schedules, including which ensembles or roles will be called for rehearsals, will be shared bi-weekly. Rehearsals will run Tuesdays & Thursdays, 4:30-6:30 pm and most Saturdays 9:00 am-12:00 pm. Evening rehearsal times will be extended in the months of December and January.

TECH CREW

Students interested in being a tech crew member and assisting with "behind the scenes" production work should register for the audition and indicate interest in tech crew.
