Ballet Dress Code

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- All dancers should wear clothes over their ballet uniform when coming to and from class.
- Ballet shoes may NOT be worn outside as it will ruin your shoes and track dirt and other outside materials onto our dance floor.
- Underwear is NOT to be worn under leotard and tights.
- Long hair should be worn in a ballet bun. Hair that is too short for a bun should be secured away from the face.
- Only small earrings are allowed in class. All other jewelry or watches must be removed prior to class.
- Dance sweaters are allowed for all classes during the cold seasons until the teacher asks them to be removed during class time. Skirts and other warm-ups are only allowed for Ballet 2-5.
- Water bottles are only allowed in the classroom for Pre-Ballet 3 and Ballet 1-5 classes.

Please check the chart below to make sure you have the correct brand, color and style leotard. We use this uniform as a base for our costumes for different performances throughout the year and want to make sure everyone has the same and correct leotard, tights, and shoes.

NOTE: All Pre-Ballet 1-3 classes have a new required leotard as of the 2025-2026 season. Please make sure the tag says “Bloch” and the leotard should be made of silky/nylon material; NOT cotton material. We are doing a soft start of this new leotard in the summer of 2025. If your child is in a new level in the fall then that they are taking in the summer, please only get the new leotard they need for the fall. The Boys/Men’s uniforms are new as of September 2024.

WARM-UPS: Sweaters are allowed for all classes but must only be in the color black (previously purchased items in other colors may be used till grown out of). Other warm-ups must be black or approved by the teacher. Please make sure warm-ups are tight fitting and not baggy.

Irish Dress Code

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- SSA has a limited number of used dance shoes and new socks in stock for purchase.
- For any new shoes, socks, or accessories, they can order through [Gibson Irish Dance Imports](#). Please check with the teacher before ordering so they can confirm shoe size and style or that any accessory being ordered is correct.
- Poodle socks should be the [Reel Champ Ultra Lows](#) - if they do not own these, they will need to purchase them if they are in troupe or showcase.
- [Black leotards](#) for shows will be needed for Novice 2 and up.
- IMPORTANT: Dancers in Novice 1 and up **MUST** wear black leggings or black shorts! If dancers are wearing anything other than this, they will be asked to change before coming back to class. Novice 1 and up dancers must also wear black top or Schauer Center t-shirt. If they don't own either of these, then any athletic top is appropriate as long as it is a plain tee.
- Long hair should be secured away from face. No jewelry allowed.
